We work with many local schools and colleges as well as Care Homes and in outreach programmes in the local area and aim to become a key contributor in the community. As a coach you could be running breakfast and after school clubs to children aged between 8 and 16 as well as club sessions across both our venues: **Thomas A Becket Primary School and Worthing High School in Worthing**. Focusing on strong communication to build good relationships with the players, parents and schools. We strive to build and grow the opportunities our players have to participate in competitions so you will have opportunities to develop your skills across: umpiring, tournament organisation and referring. There may also be opportunities to deliver half term and holiday camps during the school holidays.

The Person

To be considered for this role:

- Must hold a minimum of a Table Tennis England Level 1 Coaching Qualification (or equivalent). *(Essential)*
- Experience of successfully delivering Table Tennis sessions for children and young people in a school, community or sports club environment. *(Essential)*
- Be a confident IT user. *(Desirable)*
- Be confident with handling Table Tennis equipment (setting up/put down tables, etc).
- Good organisational skills which are required to effectively plan and manage your programme of sessions.
- Good communication to proactively liaise with parents, colleagues and schools/venues. *(Essential)*
- Be enthusiastic, friendly, proactive, organised, punctual, responsible and confident.
- Have the ability to work under pressure.
- You will have the opportunity to work with more senior coaches to develop your skills.
- Adaptable and have a flexible approach to work across the table tennis season, including the availability to work evenings and weekends where necessary. *(Essential)*

- Driving License and own transport (*Desirable*)

You will be highly passionate about the Worthing TTC mission, values and beliefs by providing an inclusive place to play for all players and strive to develop and grow their skills whatever their background.

Coach Responsibilities

- Plan and deliver Table Tennis sessions across Worthing and West Sussex areas.
- Ensure sessions are appropriate to the players within.
- To become familiar with Worthing TTC's projects, mission and values.
- Support in administration duties (ie. registration of new players, complete competition forms, etc).
- Record session's payments.
- Communicate with schools, parents, players and other stakeholders.
- Recruit players to club sessions.
- Identify enthusiastic young players and report to Head Coach.
- Store and handle equipment.

We believe in retaining and supporting our staff. The selected candidate will join a friendly team who are all passionate about table tennis and its community. The club will support the role holder to develop their coaching skills and experience, support with travel and its expenses and work together on possible further opportunities or full-time contracts if desired.
