1. Entries along with PAYMENT must be RECEIVED by email info@worthingttc.com by no later than 1st October 2026
2. The Draw will be held on 2nd October 26 2026
3. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.
4. Payment must be made by bank transfer by the closing date (or immediately for late entries).

6. hot and cold drinks is available on site. There is ample free parking and toilets, changing rooms and shower facilities are available at the venue.
7. Butterfly R40 white balls will be used.
8. Play will take place on up to 12 Tibhar Smash Green Tables , with Tibhar Smash Net and post sets and Tibhar Scoring Machines.
9. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height: 7m; Minimum Court Size: 9m X 4.5m.
10. Lighting is general & fluorescent lighting. Minimum light intensity is 400 lux. Minimum height of lighting: 7m.
11. The venue has wooden sprung flooring.
12. There will be no admission charge.
13. Competitors will be informed by email that their entry has been received within 1 day of the entry being received and a confirmation email with more details will be sent out 2 days before the event. If you do not receive this, please get in touch with Matt Porter
14. No refunds are possible after the closing date under any circumstances.
15. The planned format is progressive KO, teams will continue to play till there is a finished ranking from 1-32. each team game will follow 1v1, 2v2, where the score is 1-1, in the group the two winners will play, in the Knock out rounds the two losers will play.
16. Only the players/coach named on the match card for the match in question are authorised to be present and to give advice at the playing area
17. Definition of each category is: Juniors – born in 2008 or later,
18. Winner and Runners Up will receive a medal.
19. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
